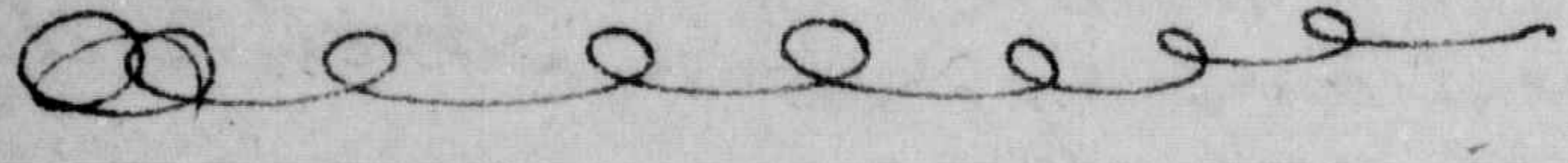

to  
Negro Amey I shall come greeting I William Weems  
of Ann Arundel County in the State aforesaid for diverse  
good Causes and Considerations more thereunto moving  
do hereby free manumit and enfranchise the Negro  
following to wit, Amey aged thirty years to be  
free in five years from the date hereof hereby —  
Acknowledging the said Negro Discharged from all  
Claim of Service and right of property whatever from  
me my heirs Executors Administrators or assigns  
as witness my hand and seal this sixth day of  
April in the blessed year of our Lord one thousand  
seven hundred and ninety nine
