

Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good
Causes and Considerations me thereunto moving do free
manumit liberate and enfranchise after the first
day of January Anno Domini eighteen hundred and
two one Negro Man named Isaac aged about forty
years thereby acknowledging said Isaac forever
Discharged from all Claim of Service and right of
property whatsoever from me my heirs Executors Agents
and Administrators after the aforesaid first day of
January Anno Domini eighteen hundred and two In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my Seal this twenty seventh of April Anno Domini
seventeen hundred and Ninety seven
