

men of the City of Annapolis in the said State do hereby manumit liberate and set free the following Negroes at the respective periods hereinafter mentioned to wit, I manumit liberate and set free from the first day of October in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and seven a certain Negro Man named Charles Pembroke son of Sukey Pembroke and I hereby manumit liberate & set free from the first day of October in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fourteen a certain Negro boy named Powertill Pembroke son of the aforesaid Sukey Pembroke at which respective Periods above mentioned the said Negroes are to be liberated and Discharged from Slavery In Testimony whereof I have to these presents set and Affixed my hand and Seal this twenty fifth day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred.
