Maryland do hereby set free from bondage my
negro Man called Rachel about fifty years old
and also my mulatto Man called Anthony
Nicols aged about forty five and do for myself
my Executors and Administrators release unto
the aforesaid Negroes all my right whatsoever
declaring the said Negroes absolutely free
from the date hereof without any interruption
from me or any persons claiming under me
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this Eleventh day of May eighteen
hundred and one

On the back of the foregoing was thus endorsed by
Anne Arundel County Court, On the Eleventh day of
May eighteen hundred and one Henry Maynardier
appeared before me the subscribed one of the
Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid and
acknowledged the within instrument of writing
to be his Act and Deed and the Negroes above
mentioned to be manumitted and free according
to the Act of Assembly in that behalf made & provided
