John Brown I know all persons before whose presence these may come That I John Brown of George Doemans am arundel County State of Maryland doth hereby set free from Bondage my Mulatto Boy named George Doeman when he arrives to the age of Seventy one years which will be in September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and four and do for myself and my heirs executors and administrators release unto the above named Boy after the before mentioned period all my right and all claims whatsoever to his person or to any property or estate that he may thereafter acquire hereby declaring the said Boy absolutely free
