

after the first day of January next manumit set free & forever discharge from my Service the said Negro woman Sibb alias Sibbora alias Siberia that is to say it is my will and the intent of these presents that the said woman shall serve me and be considered as my Slave until the first day of January next and no longer and that from and after that time she shall be free to all intents and purposes any Act which I may hereafter do to the contrary notwithstanding In witness whereof I do hereby set my hand and affix my Seal this twenty fourth day of May in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and Ninety seven
