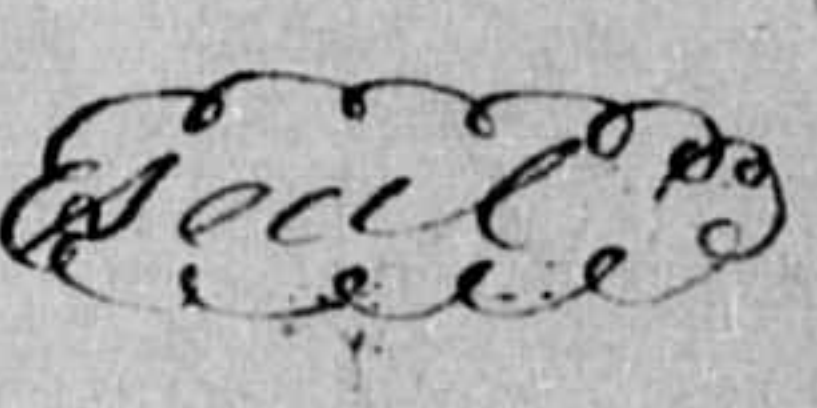


Leonard Scott } To all whom it may concern be it known that I  
 do hereby }  
 Lucy Scott } Leonard Scott of the City of Annapolis in the  
 State of Maryland for divers good causes and  
 considerations me therunto moving as also in further considera-  
 tion of the sum of five shillings current money to me  
 in hand paid have released from Slavery, liberated  
 manumitted and set free and by these presents do  
 release from Slavery, manumit, liberate and set free  
 my negro girl named Lucy Scott, being of the age of  
 fourteen years or thereabouts and whom I purchased  
 of and from a certain Joseph S. Bell of Montgomery  
 County in the State aforesaid and her the said  
 negro girl named Lucy Scott. I do declare to be hence-  
 forth free manumitted and discharged from all  
 manner of servitude or service to me my executors  
 or administrators forever. In Testimony whereof  
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this  
 21<sup>st</sup> day of October one Thousand eight hundred and one.

Anne Arundel County J<sup>t</sup> Be it remembered that on this  
 day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred  
 and one personally appeared Leonard Scott party to  
 the within instrument of writing before the subscribers two  
 of the Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid  
 and acknowledges the same to be his act and deed for the  
 purposes within mentioned and the negro girl within  
 named to be henceforth manumitted and discharged  
 from all services to him, or to any claiming under  
 him, and to be free and manumitted according  
 to the act of assembly in such cases made and  
 provided. Acknowledged before.
