Lundry ^{to} Negroes } that I William Thomas Yeldell
of the City of Annapolis in the
County of Ann Arundel County in the State of Maryland
for myself and all claiming under me for and in
consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to
me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, do hereby manumit emancipate and
set free from slavery and discharge from my
service and the service of all and every person
or persons whatever the following slaves to wit.
a black or coloured woman called and known
by the name of Suckey aged about twenty one
years and her two children a mulatto girl called
and named Matilda and a mulatto boy called and
named James to be free on this fifth day of November
in
