


Know all men by these presents that I William

 Margaret who is of a healthy constitution and
 sound in mind and body capable by Labour
 to procure sufficient food and Raiment with
 other requisite necessaries of life Have manumitted
 and set free and by these presents do manumit
 and set free the said negroe woman slave
 named Margaret. As witness my hand and
 seal this thirtieth day of May Eighteen hundred and one
 signed sealed and delivered

On the back of the foregoing was thus endorsed by
 Anne Arundel County May 30th 1801. the within
 named William Kitty appeared before the
 subscriber one of the justices of the peace
 for the said County and acknowledged the

 manumitted and set free and by these presents
 do release from slavery manumit liberate
 and set free my negroe girl named Lucy
 Scott being of the age of fourteen years or
 thereabouts and whom I purchased of a
 certain
