Jones and her child William Jones the woman  
aged thirty years and her child aged four years and  
able to work and gain her livelihood and her the said  
negro woman named Chrisp Jones and her child  
named William Jones, and I do hereby declare  
the said Chrisp Jones henceforth free manumitted and  
discharged from all manner of servitude or service  
to me my executors or administrators forever, and  
I do hereby declare the said William Jones shall  
be free manumitted and discharged from and after  
the first day of January in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight  
from all manner of servitude or service  
to me my executors or administrators forever  
In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set  
my hand and affixed my seal the  
fourteenth day of July in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and ten,
