that I Elizabeth Givinn of the City of Annapolis
in the State of Maryland widow of John Givinn
Esquire of the said City deceased, for divers good
causes and considerations me thereunto moving,
as also in further consideration of one Dollar
current money to me in hand paid. Have released
from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free
and by these presents Do hereby release from
slavery, liberate, manumit and set free, my
negro man named Evans being of the age of
forty four years, and able to work and gain a
sufficient livelihood and maintenance and which
said negro man named Evans, I purchased of
the administrator of my said deceased husband
and him the said negro man named Evans
I do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted
and discharged from all manner of servitude
or service to me my, executors or administrators
forever.
