


Maryland Sec

I David Weems of Anne Arundel County in the
State of Maryland, for divers good causes and
considerations me thereunto moving, do hereby
declare free, manumit and enfranchise negro
Iam, commonly called James Booth, hereby
acknowledging the said negro discharged from
all claim of service and right of property
whatsoever from me, my heirs, executors or
administrators. As witness my hand and seal
the 24 Day of September Eighteen Hundred and
Ten

On the back of the foregoing, deed was thus
endorsed to wit.

Then came David Weems, before me
the subscriber one of the justices of peace for
the County aforesaid and acknowledged the
above to be his act and deed, according to
the intent and meaning thereof.

Recorded the 25th September 1810. Henry Childs
