To all whom these presents shall come Greeting I Nicholas Swornstedt of Anne Arundel County in the State aforesaid for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving do hereby full manumit and enfranchise the negros following to wit, Cal to be free the first of January Eighteen hundred and twenty four, Grace to be free the first of January eighteen hundred and thirty one, Seaney to be free the first of January eighteen hundred and twenty nine, Harriet to be free the first of January eighteen hundred and thirty three Luce to be free the first of January eighteen hundred and thirty three, the increase of they above to go free the male at twenty five years of age and female to go free at twenty one years of age to the latest generation, Hereby acknowledging the said negros shall go free as they arrive at the time above mentioned from all claim of service and right of property whatever from me my heirs, executors administrators or assigns, as witness my hand and seal this 22nd of October in the year of our Lords eighteen hundred and ten.
