

To all whom it may concern, Be it known that I Geth Sweetser of Ann Arundel County in the State of Maryland, for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving, as also for the further sum of five shillings & 6^pts money, to me paid as also in further consideration of services done, have released from slavery liberated manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate manumitt and set free my negro woman named Henry being of the age of thirty years and able to work and gain a
