 is the right of all men, do hereby set free and
 manumit the following negroes and their
 issue, at the respective periods of time and in
 the manner ^{following} to wit, negro Bill aged about
 forty four years to be free from the date hereof
 negro Paul aged about forty four years
 to be free from the date hereof negro Jacob
 aged about forty four years to be free from
 the date hereof negro Jack aged about
 forty years to be free from the date hereof
 negro Suba aged about thirty six years
 to be free from the date hereof, negro
 Abram aged about twenty five years to
 be free from the date hereof negro Ben
 aged about twenty years to be free in one
 year
