To all whom it may concern, be it known, that
 I Thomas Shickells of Anne Arundel County
 in the State of Maryland for divers good causes
 and consideration of five shillings current
 money to me in hand paid, have released
 from slavery, liberated, manumitted and
 set free, and by these presents, do hereby
 release from slavery, liberate, manumit
 and set free my negro lad named George
 being about nineteen years of age from and
 after the term of my natural life, and him
 the said negro lad named George I do declare
 to be (from and after the term of my natural
 life aforesaid) free manumitted, and
 discharged from all manner of servitude
 or service to my executors or administrators
