

Know all men by these presents that I Horatio Samuel Gibson of Anne Arundel County for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving have manumitted, liberated and set free a certain negro woman I have named Patty aged thirty five years and by these presents do manumit, liberate and set free the said negro woman Patty and each of the children or issue that the said Patty may hereafter bring forth. Herely declaring her the said Patty and all and every the issue she may hereafter have to be totally and absolutely free clear and exempt from all kind of claim or demands of myself my heirs, executors and administrators. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hands and affixed my seal on this eleventh day of January in the year of our Lords one thousand eight hundred and eleven.
