dollars current money of the United States to me in hand
paid by Patty Lee a free black woman at or before
the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold
and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto
the said Patty Lee her infant child named Henry now
six months old To have and to hold the said Henry
for and during the term of twelve years from the date
hereof and after the said term of twelve years is
complete and ended, I do hereby declare the
said negro boy Henry the son of Patty
Lee, to be manumitted librated and free from
all kind of servitude to myself my heirs or
assigns, and do hereby warrant and defend the
freedom of said Henry against all and every
person whomsoever, In testimony whereof I
