 G. Tuck of Anne Arundel county in the state of Maryland
 for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving
 as also in further consideration of five dollars current money
 to me in hand paid have released from slavery/ liberated
 manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release
 from slavery/ liberate manumitt and set free my negro girl named
 Sophia at the age of twenty five years and now being of the age
 of one year her the said negro girl named Sophia I
 do declare to be after she arrives to the age of twenty five
 years free manumitted and discharged from all manner
 of servitude or service to me my executors or administrators
 forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and affixed my seal this 2nd day of April
 in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and
 eleven
