 release from slavery liberate manumitted and set
 free after my death, my negro man named Philip
 Browner being between the age of twenty five and thirty
 years, and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and
 maintenance, and him the said negro man named Philip
 Browner, I do declare to be free manumitted and discharged
 from all manner of servitude or service to my executors or
 administrators forever after my decease, In testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
 twenty seventh day of August in the year of our Lord
 eighteen hundred and seven,
