unto the said Priscilla and her daughter Eliza all
my right and all claim whatsoever as to their
persons or to any estate they may acquire, hereby
declaring the said negroes absolutely free without
any interruption from me or any person claiming
under me. In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this twenty seventh day of
April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and eleven.
