



Know all men by these presents that we

a negro woman named Nancy Rogers and her  
daughter named Mary Rogers heretofore conveyed  
to us by Regim D. Baldwin of Anne Arundel  
County. In Witness whereof we have hereto set our  
hands and seals this twentieth day of August in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and eleven.
