

To all whom it may concern be it known that
I John Merriken of Anne Arundell County in the
State of Maryland for divers good causes and
considerations me thereunto moving do release from
Slavery manumit, liberate and set free my negro
woman Murriah she being now of the age of thirty
five years and and able to work and gain a
sufficient livelihood and maintainance and her
the said negro woman Murriah I do declare to be
henceforth free manumitted and discharged from
the date hereoff from all manner of servitude or
service to me my heirs, executors or administrators
forever. In Testimony whereoff I hereunto set my
hands and seal this fourteenth day of September
eighteen hundred and eleven.
