To all whom it may concern be it known that I Thomas W. Howard of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving as also in further consideration of five shillings current money to me in hand paid, have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery, liberate manumit and set free my negro man named Peter being of the age of forty five years, and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and him the said negro man named Peter I do declare to be henceforth free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me my executors or administrators, forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 28th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven.
