I know all men by these presents that I, Mary
 Meriwether knowing that natural Freedom
 being the right of all men given by Almighty
 God, do bind myself my heirs executors and
 administrators and assigns to set free and
 manumit the following negroes and their
 heirs forever in the following manner to wit:
 Negro Charles aged about twenty one years
 to be free in three years from this date, negro
 Suck aged about seventeen years to be free
 in four years from this date, negro Rachel
 aged about twelve years to be free in eight
 years from this date, and all the children
