


and set free my mulatto woman slave named

 Mulatto woman named Matilda Hanson
 I do declare to be henceforth free manumitted
 and discharged from all manner of servitude
 or service to me my executors or administrators
 forever. In Testimony whereof I hereunto
 subscribe my name, and affix my seal
 this second day of December in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 eleven
