


emancipation of the Mother their freedom at the time
and in the manner following, the males are to be
free as they respectively arrive to the age of twenty
one years and the females as they arrive to the
age of eighteen years as aforesaid. In Witness whereof

and provided.

I Susanna Myriel of the City of Annapolis in Ann
Arundel County and State of Maryland for divers
good purposes causes and considerations me thereunto
moving) as also in further consideration of five shillings
current money to me in hand paid have released
from slavery my negro woman (or girl) Mary aged
about fifteen years have liberated manumitted
and set free and by these presents do release from
slavery liberate manumit and set free the said
negro Mary from and after the twenty eighth day
of August one thousand eight hundred and thirty
one
