

Know all men by these presents that I John Chew Thomas of Ann Arundel County and State of Maryland do hereby manumit set free and grant freedom to my negro lad named Lloyds from and after the first day January eighteen hundred and fifteen next ensuing the date hereof. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventeenth day of June 1812.
