 maintenance and her the said mulatto named
 Milly alias Milly Lowry I do declare to be
 henceforth free manumitted and discharged from
 all manner of servitude and service and do for
 myself my executors and administrators release
 unto the said Milly or Milly Lowry all my right
 and all claim whatsoever as to her person or to
 any estate she may acquire, hereby declaring the
 said Milly alias Milly Lowry to be absolutely
 free without any interruption from me or any
 person claiming under me. In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
 twentieth fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and thirteen
