





Know all men by these presents that we George

 and by these presents manumit and set free from
 bondage on and after the first day of January
 eighteen hundred and nineteen negro Harry commonly
 called Joshua about twenty three years of age late
 the property of the said Margaret Howard deceased.
 In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands
 and affixed our seals this 13th day of November 1813.
