



To all whom it may concern, Be it known  
 that I Susanna Harrison of Anne Arundel County  
 in the State of Maryland for divers good causes  
 and considerations me thereunto moving, as also  
 in further consideration of one dollar current  
 money to me in hand paid have released from  
 slavery liberated manumitted and set free and  
 by these presents do hereby release from slavery  
 liberate manumitt and set free on the twentieth  
 day of September in the year of our Lord one  
 thousand eight hundred and twenty one my  
 mulatto girl named Kelly being of the age  
 of seventeen or eighteen years and able to work  
 and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance  
 and her the said Mulatto girl named Kelly I  
 do declare to be on the twentieth day of September  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
 hundred and twenty one to be free manumitted  
 and discharged from all manner of servitude  
 or services to me my executors or administrators
