To all whom it may concern, Be it known, that for divers
good causes me thereunto moving, I Anne Stewart of the
county aforesaid do hereby manumit and declare free
agreeably to the terms herein after specified, my four negroes
to wit: Mully aged eight years, to be free at the age of
twenty five years, Thornton aged seven years to be
free at the age of twenty five years, Mary aged
six years, to be free at the age of twenty five
years, and Nelly aged four years to be free
at the age of twenty five years, and the issue
of all the aforesaid females and the issue of
such issue shall be free at the age of twenty
five years. hereby declaring and acknowledging
the said negroes as aforesaid free and forever discharged
from all claim of service right or property
