

To all whom it may concern, Be it known that I Frederick P. Jones of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving as also in further consideration of five shillings current money to me in hand paid do by these presents liberate manumitt and set free my negro slave named Henrietta aged thirteen years to be free when she shall arrive at the age of thirty years; and I do hereby further liberate manumitt and set free all the increase of the said negro slave Henrietta, and her descendants increase as they
