To all whome it may concern, be it known
that I, Richard Weedon of Anne Arundel county
in the state of Maryland for divers good causes
and considerations me shewt moving by these
presents, do release from slavery liberate, manumit
and set free my negro woman named Nan
she being of the age of thirty five years and
able to gain a sufficient livelihood and
maintenance at my death, and not before,
and after that time I do declare my negro woman
Nan free manumitted and discharged from
