

all manner of servitude or service to my executors & administrators or any person or persons claiming under me, likewise be it known that I Richard Weedon of Anne Arundel county and State aforesaid do release from slavery/manumitt and set free the several negro children of the above named woman to wit, Charles, Rosanna, Harriott and Eliza and they shall respectively arrive at the age of thirty five years, I do hereby declare the within named negroes manumitted and discharged, as they shall respectively arrive at the age and time above specified, In witness whereof I have hereto set my hand and seal this fourteenth day of March in the year of our Lord 1800.
