and from henceforth relinquish all claim and rights  
whatev<sup>r</sup> of in and to the said mentioned persons, and do  
publist and declare them to be free: In witness whereof I  
have this twenty fifth day of April in the year of our Lord  
eighteen hundred and eight; hereto set my hand and  
affixed my seal.
