by John Brown (black man) of the City of Annapolis
and State of Maryland at or before the enrolling
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
I the said Israel T. Canby do hereby acknowledge
have granted, bargained and sold and by these
presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said
John Brown his personal liberty and all the title
interest and claim of her the said Ann Sprigg to the
services of the said John Brown. And I the said
Israel T. Canby attorney for the said Ann Sprigg
for the said Ann Sprigg her heirs executors or
administrators, the aforesaid John Brown his
personal liberty to the said John Brown against
me the said Israel T. Canby attorney for Ann Sprigg
and against her heirs and assigns forever and
against all and every person and persons
whatsoever shall and will warrant and
forever defend by these presents. In Witness
