 for his daughter Henney being five years old the
 twentieth day of August last past I hereby
 declare and acknowledge the aforesaid negro
 girl Henney to be free and forever discharged
 from all claims of service, rights or properties
 whatsoever from me or any claiming under me
 my executors administrators or assigns. In Witness

 affixed my seal this eleventh day of September
 eighteen hundred and fifteen
