3. Recorded the 31<sup>st</sup> day of September 1815.

To all whom it may concern Be it known that I  
Stephen Boone of Annapolis County, in the State  
of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations  
me thereunto moving do hereby agree that on the  
20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1837 for which time I have  
sold her to Jonas Yeover of the City of Baltimore  
to release from slavery liberate manumitted and  
set free my negro girl named Eliza who will  
be at the period above mentioned 35 years of  
age and her the said negro Eliza I do declare  
to be at the time specified, free, manumitted  
and discharged from all manner of servitude  
or service to me, my executors or administrators  
forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and affixed my seal this 3<sup>d</sup> day  
of October in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and fifteen  
signed, sealed and  
delivered in the presence of  
James Mackubin Jun<sup>r</sup>
