This Indenture Witnesseth that I Subb Tower
of the City of Annapolis in the County of Anne
Arundel and State of Maryland for and in
consideration of the sum of five dollars to
me in hand paid at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged have released from
slavery manumitted and set free and by
these presents do release from slavery manumitted
and set free the following mulatto slaves that
is to say my mulatto woman named Nancy
Smith being under forty five years of age
toward of the age of thirty years or thereabouts
my mulatto girl named Susan Smith
daughter of the said Nancy of the age of
nineteen years or thereabouts and my mulatto
girl
