Ann to be free when they arrive at the age of 35
years and then the said Ann and her increase
I do declare to be at the time specified, free
manumitted and discharged from all manner
of servitude or service to me my executors or
administrators forever. In Testimony whereof I
have hereunto set my hands and affixed my seal
this 17th day of November in the year of our Lord 1815.
