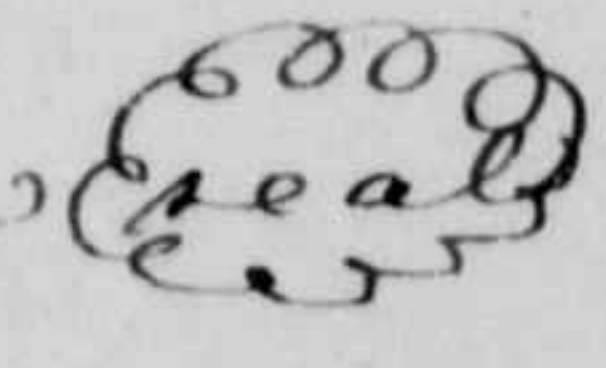


To all whom it may concern Be it known that
 I Stephen Boone of Anne Arundel County in the State
 of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations
 me thereunto moving do hereby agree to be released
 from slavery liberated manumitted and set free
 and by these presents do hereby release from slavery
 liberate manumit and set free my negro girl
 named Suckey aged 10 years to be free at the age
 of 35 years from the date of this manumission,
 also the increase of the said Suckey to be free
 when they arrive at the age of 35 years, and then the
 said negro Suckey and her increase I do declare
 to be at the time specified, free manumitted and
 discharged from all manner of servitude or service
 to me my executors or administrators forever. In
 Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hands
 and affixed my seal this 17 day of November in
 the year of our Lord 1815
 Signed, sealed and delivered }

 party to the above instrument of writing before me

 the same to be his act and deed for the purposes
 above mentioned and the negro girl above
 specified, manumitted and discharged from all
