



To all whom it may concern Be it Known that I Francis Neale of Anne Arundel county in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me therewith moving) as also in further consideration of one hundred dollars current money to me in hand paid have released from slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby set free my negro woman named Polly being of the age of forty three years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and her the said negro woman named Polly I do declare to be henceforth free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me my executors or administrators forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hands and affixed my seal this fifth day of February in the year of our Lord aughteen hundred and sixteen.
