

Anne Arundel County to wit: On this fifth day of February 1810 personally appears Francis Neale party to the within instrument of writing before me the subscriber a Justice of the peace of the State of Maryland for the said County and acknowledges the same to be his act and deed for the purposes within mentioned and the negro woman within named to be and henceforth manumitted and discharged from all services to him or to any claim under him and to be free and manumitted according to the act of Assembly in such case made and provided acknowledged before.

To all whom it may concern Be it known that I Stephen Boone of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me thereto moving do agree to be released from slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery liberate manumit and set free my negro woman named Charity when she arrives at the age of 35 years being now of the age of 30 years also the said Charitys two children Julian aged four years and Margaret aged one year I do agree to be released from slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery liberate manumit and set free the aforesaid Charitys two children Julian and Margaret when they respectively arrive at the age of 35 years and then the said negroes Charity, Julian and Margaret and their increase I do declare to be
