

On the back of the foregoing was thus endorsed to wit: Anne Chandel, bounty to wit: On this 17<sup>th</sup> day of November 1815 personally appears Stephen Boone party to the above instrument of writing before me the subscribed a Justice of the peace of the State of Maryland for the said County and acknowledged the same to be his act and deed for the purposes therein mentioned, and the negroes above mentioned to be then at the time specified & manumitted and discharged from all services to him or to any claiming under him and to be free and manumitted according to the act of Assembly in such cases made and provided acknowledged before.
