Know all men by these presents that I Harry Disney of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland do hereby manumit and set free a negro woman named Betty and her child Matilda which persons I bought of Frances Sappington on the 23<sup>d</sup> of August 1815. And I do hereby declare the said woman, her child and their issue to be free from the date hereof. Witness my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of February 1810.
