This Indenture Witnesseth that I Virgil Macey of Tulip Hill in Anne Arundel County Maryland, for and in consideration of thirty dollars to me in hand paid at & before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have released from slavery manumitted & set free by these presents do release from slavery manumitted & set free my negro girl named Eliza being under forty five years of age of a healthy constitution sound in mind and body and capable of obtaining a support having a free father named Harry Turner. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name & affixed my seal this 7th June 1816.
