Know all men by these presents that Nicholas Brewer of the City of Annapolis have and by these presents do manumit & set free from slavery a negro woman named Abby sold to me by Henry Gaither Executor of Ann Gaither and likewise her child called Sally In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this nineteenth day of August eighteen hundred & sixteen
