James Calder aged about five years and son of the said
Harriot Calder; and we do hereby also liberate,
manumit and set free from and after the first day of
January which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and nineteen, a mulatto girl named Ann
Calder, aged about three years and daughter of the
said Harriot Calder, and we do also hereby
liberate, manumit and set free from and after the first
day of January which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and twenty two, a mulatto boy named
William Calder aged about fifteen months and son
of the said Harriot Calder; and the said James,
Ann and William children of the said Harriot
Calder as aforesaid. We do declare to be thenceforth
that is to say, on the respective days above.
