and set free negro Harriott formerly my property and
slave. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
at the city of Annapolis this fourth day of April in the
year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and
nine, Rich^d H Harwood Ninian Pinkney (Seal)

On the back of the foregoing deed was thus endorsed to wit
on the fourth day of April eighteen hundred and
nine, Ninian Pinkney came before me an associate
Judge for the third Judicial District of Maryland
and acknowledged the above to be his act and
deed according to the true intent and meaning thereof.

To all whom it may concern be it known that
I Eleanor Washington Bowman of Ann Arundel
county in the state of Maryland for divers good
causes and considerations me thereunto moving
as also in further consideration of nine pounds seven
shillings and six pence current money to me in
hand paid have released from slavery liberated
manumitted and set free and by these presents
do hereby release from slavery liberate manumit
and set free my negro man named Harry
being of the age of twenty seven years and all
